

SARDIS LAKE

LOCATION OF DAM—Sardis Dam is in the Red River Basin on Jackfork Creek, a tributary of the Kiamichi River at mile 2.8, Lat. 34°37'44", Long. 95°21'02" in Sec. 19, T2N, R19E in Pushmataha County about 3 miles north of the town of Clayton and 5 miles northwest of Tuskahoma.

CONSTRUCTION STATUS—Constructed by Corps of Engineers—Construction began in August 1975 and was completed in 1982. Impoundment was initiated in January 1983. Cost of the project was \$67,893,000.

PURPOSE/AUTHORIZATION—Flood control, water supply, recreation and fish and wildlife. Authorized by the Flood Control Act approved October 23, 1962. Project Document SD 145, 87th Congress, Second Session.

STRUCTURE DATA— The dam is a rolled earthfill structure 14,138 feet long and 32 feet wide at the top and rises 81 feet above the streambed. The 215-foot wide uncontrolled spillway has a design capacity of 29,400 cfs at maximum pool elevation.

DRAINAGE AREA—275 square miles

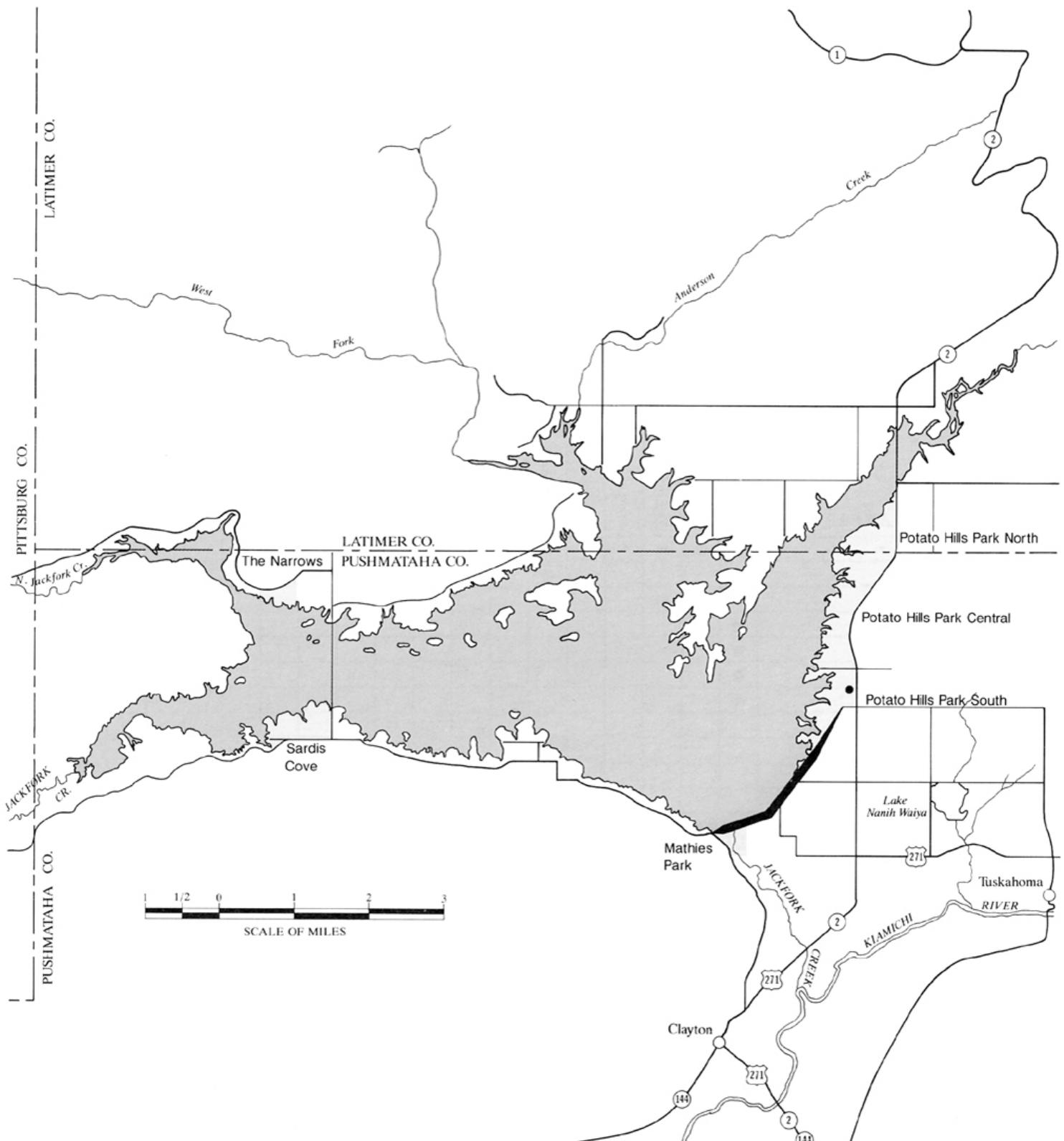
DEPTH—Mean 21.05 ft., Max. 49 ft. Based on normal pool elevation.
